Mr. Chang Ka Mun is the Managing Director of Li & Fung Development (China) Limited and Li & Fung Research Centre under the Li & Fung Group. Mr. Chang focused on studying China's national and regional economic strategies as well as economic, social and political development in the Mainland.

Mr. Chang is currently a National Member of the 11th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and a Council Member of Chinese Society of Macroeconomics of National Development and Reform Commission of the People's Republic of China. He is a Staff Officer of Hong Kong Greater Pearl River Delta Business Council, and an Advisory Council Member of Brookings Institution (Center for Northeast Asian Policy Studies, CNAPS) USA. He is also the Secretary-General of China Economic Research Foundation and Secretary-General of 2022 Research Foundation.

Mr. Chang was a Member of the Basic Law Consultative Committee of the National People's Congress of the PRC (1985-1990), Hong Kong Affairs Advisor of the State Council of the PRC (1994-1997), as well as the Preparatory Committee of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (1996-1997). He was also a Member of Transport Advisory Committee and Commission on Strategic Development of Hong Kong.

Before joining Li & Fung, Mr. Chang was a Director of Peregrine Brokerage China Ltd. and a Consultant of the Centre of Economic Competitiveness of SRI International of the United States (formerly Stanford Research Institute).
